Package Overview

We offer a combination freshwater and saltwater angling adventure for Chinook Salmon in freshwater and Halibut, Ling Cod, and Rock Fish on the ocean. Spend three days angling for giant Kings on the wild Skeena and Kitimat rivers with snow-capped mountains in the background, mix in two days on the ocean fishing for Halibut on the off tides, and you've got a trip you won't soon forget! In 2008, this package is available June 8 to July 11.

The World's Biggest Kings



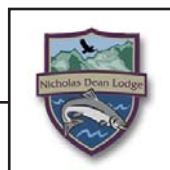
Chinook season in Northwestern British Columbia is a season like no other. The rivers are full of massive Chinook (King) Salmon — which average an astounding 20 to 50 pounds. Fish over 70 pounds are caught every year and there is even a chance at a salmon over 100 pounds! These powerful fish are fresh from the sea, in peak condition and will test your angling skills.

Plentiful Halibut

In the waters off Prince Rupert, Halibut are plentiful and average 20 to 60 pounds, but fish up to 400 lbs have also been caught. These fish are scrappy, fun fighters and are incredibly tasty in the frying pan. We offer day packages that include all the fishing gear and bait required.

Summer in the Air

The weather in June and early July is mild and quite often sunny with the sweet smell of summer in the air. The towering mountains are clad in every shade of green with their great granite tops streaked with snow and wrapped in clouds.

Day of Arrival

This includes pick up from the airport, lodging, accommodations and appetizers and/or dinner, depending on arrival time.

Day 1

Lower Kitimat River

Back trolling, spoon fishing, wet fly fishing, and bottom bouncing

This is the season of the Chinook on the Kitimat River. These fish average 20 to 40 pounds and reach 80 pounds. They are fresh, powerful fish only a few miles from the sea. We float the Lower Kitimat in drift boats.

Day 2

Prince Rupert

Spreader bars with bait and jigging

The ocean surrounding Prince Rupert teems with bottom fish including Halibut, Ling Cod, Rock Cod and all kinds of other odd creatures. Enjoy an exciting and productive day of Halibut fishing on some of the North Pacific's best Halibut water.

Day 3

Skeena River

Plunking, bottom bouncing, back bouncing, and wet fly fishing

The broad Skeena River is the superhighway for thousands of Chinook Salmon headed to one of many tributary streams. The Skeena has the largest Chinooks in the world, with fish up to 100 pounds possible. Access is by jet boat.

Day 4

Prince Rupert

Spreader bars with bait and jigging

The ocean surrounding Prince Rupert teems with bottom fish including Halibut, Ling Cod, Rock Cod and all kinds of other odd creatures. Enjoy an exciting and productive day of Halibut fishing on some of the North Pacific's best Halibut water.

Day 5

Kitimat River Estuary

Back trolling, spoon fishing, wet fly fishing, and bottom bouncing

In the Kitimat River Estuary can be found some of the hottest Chinook anywhere. Catch huge, chrome-fresh Chinook Salmon in shallow water — where they put up the most incredible show possible. Unable to sound, these fish make long, line-ripping runs. These Chinooks even jump! Access is by jet boat.

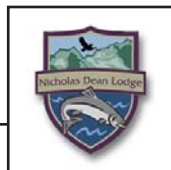

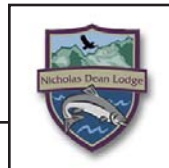
RESERVATION & DEPOSITS: RESERVE EARLY TO **GUARANTEE YOUR TRIP IN THE PREFERRED SEASON!** A deposit of 50% must be received by the lodge within 7 business days of contact to hold your reservation. Deposits are valid only for the calendar year in which your trip is booked, and are refunded only as set out below. The final payment of 50% is due 90 days (3 months) before the scheduled trip and is non-refundable.

Deposits will be refunded less a \$300.00 CDN cancellation fee if written notice of cancellation is received by Nicholas Dean Lodge management 180 days (6 months) before the scheduled trip. No penalty will be assessed if the client has an immediate replacement at the time of cancellation. If written notice of cancellation is received less than 180 days (6 months) before the scheduled trip, the

deposit will not be refunded, but if space is available your booking may be transferred to another later date in the same season less a \$300.00 CDN rebooking fee. All deposits and final payments are only valid for the calendar year (March 15 to November 15), after which all deposits and final payments are forfeit.

Nicholas Dean Lodge is a small company and cancellations are very costly. In order to protect trip payments, it is highly recommended that cancellation insurance be purchased. Cancellation insurance is available at most travel agencies, and can be purchased locally in Terrace through Elan Travel at (250) 635-2281.

We accept VISA, MASTERCARD, and DEBIT CARD. PERSONAL CHECKS or CASH MAY BE ACCEPTED IN SPECIAL CASES.



Additional Information

Package includes:

- 5% Canadian Federal Government Goods & Services Tax (GST)
- 8% Canadian Provincial Government Room Tax
- Transportation to and from Terrace Airport
- Accommodation
- Breakfast (7 AM or earlier), packed lunch and evening meal (7 PM)
- Jet-boat and/or drift-boat
- Transportation to and from river
- Approximately nine hours guided angling daily
- Care/preparation of your catch for return trip

Package does not include:

- Transportation from your place of residence to Terrace, BC Airport and return
- Items of a personal nature
- Gratuities
- Alcoholic beverages
- Fishing licenses
- Fish coolers

Gratuities:

- Suggested angling guide gratuity, for a job well done, \$40–\$60 per day per person
- Suggested lodge staff gratuity, for a job well done, \$25–\$35 per day per person

Fish Packaging (not applicable March – May and November)

■ We will gladly clean “in season” Salmon and Halibut, if you would like to take home some of your catch. Extra costs are incurred for coolers and dry ice (approximately \$35 per guest) and vacuum sealing (\$15 for fish under 30”, \$25 for fish over 30”). Guides will leave the river one hour early to process your Salmon. Please keep in mind the baggage limits for the airlines as extra baggage and/or weight can incur additional fees from the airlines.

Itinerary notes:

- On day of arrival you will be met at the airport and transported to the fishing lodge which takes about 20 minutes. You will be asked if you would like to make a purchase at the local liquor store. The liquor store does accept credit cards. Angling licenses will be sold to you at the lodge (4% extra if paid with credit card) and fishing plans for the next days will be discussed.
- On guided fishing days breakfast will be served at 7 AM or earlier. After breakfast your guide and boat (if needed) will be ready to take you fishing all day. Your packed lunch includes two sandwiches (varied each day), hot soup, sweet roll, fruit and/or vegetables, ice water, soft drinks plus your choice of hot drink. You will come off the river and return to the lodge between 5:30 and 6:30 PM where hors d’oeuvres will be served with dinner at 7 PM.
- On day of departure lodging, accommodations, full breakfast and transportation to the airport are included.
