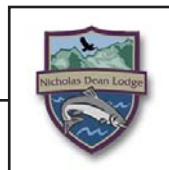

DAY BOOKING PACKAGES

Fish Species, Season and Size

Nicholas Dean Lodge offers Day Booking services for all five species of Pacific Salmon and Steelhead. Our Fishing Season Starts in mid-March and continues through mid-November with peak fishing for different species throughout this season. The different season for each species is listed below. Please inquire for specific dates.

Steelhead	Mid-March through Mid-May and Aug through Mid-Nov
Chinook	Mid-April through Mid-August
Coho	Mid-August through October
Sockeye	July through August
Chum	July through Mid-September
Pink	August through Mid-September

Not only are the Salmon and Steelhead stocks abundant but many of the largest Salmon and Steelhead in the world are found in the Skeena and Nass watersheds.

Chinook (King)	20 to 50	75 to 85	100+
Steelhead	8 to 20	30 to 35	44+
Coho (Silver)	8 to 20	25 to 30	30+

RESERVATION & DEPOSITS: RESERVE EARLY TO **GUARANTEE YOUR TRIP IN THE PREFERRED SEASON!** A deposit of 50% must be received by the lodge within 7 business days of contact to hold your reservation. Deposits are valid only for the calendar year in which your trip is booked, and are refunded only as set out below. The final payment of 50% is due 90 days (3 months) before the scheduled trip and is non-refundable.

Deposits will be refunded less a \$300.00 CDN cancellation fee if written notice of cancellation is received by Nicholas Dean Lodge management 180 days (6 months) before the scheduled trip. No penalty will be assessed if the client has an immediate replacement at the time of cancellation. If written notice of cancellation is received less than 180 days (6 months) before the scheduled trip, the

deposit will not be refunded, but if space is available your booking may be transferred to another later date in the same season less a \$300.00 CDN rebooking fee. All deposits and final payments are only valid for the calendar year (March 15 to November 15), after which all deposits and final payments are forfeit.

Nicholas Dean Lodge is a small company and cancellations are very costly. In order to protect trip payments, it is highly recommended that cancellation insurance be purchased. Cancellation insurance is available at most travel agencies, and can be purchased locally in Terrace through Elan Travel at (250) 635-2281.

We accept VISA, MASTERCARD, and DEBIT CARD. PERSONAL CHECKS or CASH MAY BE ACCEPTED IN SPECIAL CASES.



What is Included

Nicholas Dean Lodge Day package includes:

- A minimum 8 hours of fishing time with a professional guide
- Jet boat or drift boat trip when required
- Rods and reels are provided
- A reasonable amount of tackle
- Pick-up and drop-off from hotel or campsite (Terrace or Kitimat only)
- Safety equipment (life jackets, first aid kit, etc.)

Not included in the regular package:

- Fishing licenses
- Waders, specialty clothing and the like
- Lunch (unless specifically paid for)
- Any other gear and equipment not listed above

Package rate: \$695 CDN 2 anglers, \$945 CDN 3 anglers
